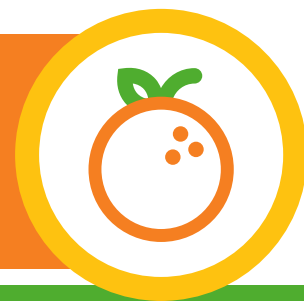

## CHECK THIS OUT!

STUDENTS 18-49 WHO ATTEND HIGHER EDUCATION AT LEAST HALF TIME MAY BE ELIGIBLE FOR SNAP -SUPPLEMENTAL NUTRITION ASSISTANCE PROGRAM - BY MEETING INCOME GUIDELINES AND ADDITIONAL CRITERIA.

TWO	\$2,607
THREE	\$3,288

STUDENTS ATTENDING CLASS LESS THAN HALF TIME AND THOSE AGE 50+ DO NOT NEED TO MEET ANY ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS.

## 2. ADDITIONAL CRITERIA

STUDENTS MUST ALSO MEET AT LEAST ONE OF THE FOLLOWING.\*

- WORKING 20 HOURS A WEEK
- CARING FOR A CHILD UNDER SIX
- PARTICIPATING IN AN EMPLOYMENT DEPARTMENT TRAINING PROGRAM
- UNABLE TO WORK DUE TO PHYSICAL OR PHYSIOLOGICAL DIFFICULTIES
- WORKING IN A FEDERALLY-FUNDED WORK-STUDY POSITION- ANY NUMBER OF HOURS
- COMMUNITY COLLEGE STUDENT PARTICIPATING IN COURSES OR PREREQUISITES OF A CAREER AND TECHNICAL EDUCATION PROGRAM OR CAREER PATHWAYS PROGRAM AS DEFINED BY THE SCHOOL.
- RECEIVING UNEMPLOYMENT
- RECEIVING TANF ASSISTANCE
